 Leading the design in 2018 of the most in depth and most responded ICA member survey on record, allowing the ICA to better understand ICA members' needs and expectations.

- Elaboration with the ICA board of the <u>ICA 2020-2030 Strategic Plan</u>, requested by the 2017 ICA General Assembly in Kuala Lumpur and approved by the 2019 General Assembly in Kigali.
- Organisation and programming of the <u>ICA Kigali conference "Cooperatives for Development"</u> with the involvement of the whole ICA global team, as well as the ICA Regional and Sectoral Organisations; second ICA global conference ever held in Africa and first fully dedicated to development, with around 1000 participants from 94 countries; largest event of the 2016-2021 ICA-EU Framework Partnership Agreement.

- Lobbied for the insertion of a reference to cooperatives in the <u>ILO Centenary</u> <u>Declaration on the Future of Work</u>, one of the key ILO documents, through my two-week lobbying in Geneva at the International Labour Conference (ILC) in 2019.
